

Technology Camp 2018 – Code of Conduct

Oysters & Pearls – Uganda believes that our community is open for everyone to explore, create, and experience learning and creativity. We're dedicated to providing a friendly and inclusive environment.

This code of conduct outlines our expectations for attendees' behavior at Technology Camp 2018, as well as the consequences for unacceptable behavior. We expect all participants (teachers, students, staff and other attendees) to abide by this code of conduct at all Camp activities.

Expected Behavior

First and foremost, treat everyone with respect. Participate while acknowledging that everyone deserves to be here, and every participant has the right to enjoy their experience without fear of harassment, discrimination, or condescension. • Be considerate, respectful, and collaborative and punctual for class.

- Refrain from demeaning, discriminatory, or harassing behavior and speech.
- Be mindful of your surroundings and of your fellow Camp participants.
- Alert the Camp Administrator if you notice a dangerous situation or someone in distress.

Unacceptable Behavior

Unacceptable behaviors include, but are not limited to the following:

- Intimidating, harassing, abusive, discriminatory, derogatory, or demeaning conduct by any participant of the Camp and related events.
- Harassment includes: offensive verbal comments related to gender, race, religion, or disability; deliberate intimidation, stalking, or following; inappropriate physical contact, and unwelcome sexual attention.
- Misusing Camp property causing it to break or malfunction.
- Removal of any supplies, materials or technology from any classroom without express permission will result in a theft charge and reported to the Police.
- Possession of any item that can be used as a weapon, which may cause danger to others if used in a certain manner.

 Any boisterous, lewd, or offensive behavior or language, including but not limited to using sexually explicit or offensive language, materials, or conduct, or any language, behavior, or content that contains profanity, obscene gestures, or racial, religious, gender, or ethnic slurs.

Consequences of Unacceptable Behavior

Unacceptable behavior will not be tolerated and may result in expulsion from the program; any criminal offense will be reported to the police.

What to Do If You Witness or Are Subject to Unacceptable Behavior Speak up! Harassment will not be tolerated in any form at the Technology Camp. If you are subject to unacceptable behavior, notice that someone else is being subjected to unacceptable behavior, or have any other concerns, please notify a teacher or other Camp staff immediately.
